Position: SALT Ministries Leader

POSITION ELIGIBILITY :

POSITION PURPOSE

- The SALT Ministries leader will be responsible for co-ordinating, facilitating, supporting and promoting student run spiritual activities for Avondale University's Lake Macquarie Campus.

KEY RESPONSIBILITIES

- Planning and co-ordinating two weeks of spiritual emphasis (Festival of Faith) for Avondale University
- Maintaining a close working relationship with, and reporting to, the ASA President and the Chaplain; seeking advice and assistance to ensure a well-balanced and well-suited program of events is achieved each semester
- Attend student leadership training sessions
- Participate in Orientation Week events, e.g., part of the welcome team
- Attend ASA meetings
- Regularly update the ASA President on all spiritual events and plans
- Ensure all Student Associated Ministry activities conform to Avondale's overall mission, vision, values and ethos
- Ensure adequate and appropriate advertising is carried out, in consultation with the ASL Media Officer
- Effectively develop and support leaders for each spiritual focused program
- Work with student leaders to initiate spiritual focused programmes as required
- Participate in the Friday night spiritual program "SALT".
- Host one PULSE program per semester, promoting spiritual ministries and activities/programs.
- Participate in PULSE, e.g., set-up, pack-down and part of the ASA information stall to promote campus spiritual life.

- Uphold Avondale's mission, vision, values and ethos
- Strong people skills
- Ability to work as part of a team and equally well working independently
- Good communication skills
- Be a student at Avondale University
- Needs to be a highly dedicated, organised and trustworthy person.
- Have a personal relationship with Jesus.

COMMUNITY

Organize the following community events in collaboration with the Chaplain and the other SALT Ministries Leaders

- Festival of Faith
- PULSE
 - > Work in collaboration with the Chaplain and ASA President to run PULSE each week.
- Fireside Fridays
 - > A monthly program working in collaboration with the Chaplain and inviting local Adventist schools and church communities to Friday night programs catering for them specifically once a month
- SALT Friday Night Program

COMMISSIONED

Have a heart for service and work in collaboration with the Chaplain and the other SALT Ministries Leaders to organize and develop the following:

- Flipped
- StormCo
- Program ongoing service opportunities alongside local schools, businesses, and church to help community
- Fridays of Festival of Faith Serve Day
- Host one pulse per semester
- Overseas Missions

CREATIVE

- Work in collaboration with the Chaplain to roll out these initiatives:
- Organize frequent creative nights where Praise and Worship teams can be sourced from

- Work in collaboration with the Chaplain and Avondale Conservatorium Director to run a Festival Choir during Festival of Faith night programs
- Manage the SALT Instagram page in consultation with the ASL Media Officer and the Chaplain
- Organize the design and graphics of all events and activities needing to be advertised for SALT Ministries
- Plan and organize special items of various arts for our weekly Friday night programs, Festivals of Faith, and further special occasions
- Collaborate with a videographer to create videos as needed. (for example highlight reels from Festival of Faith and promotion videos for upcoming events)
- Host one Pulse per semester
- Organise a roster for Praise and Worship Teams for Friday night programs

CONNECTED

- Work in collaboration with Res Mentors and Chaplain to facilitate regular Res Hall worships
- Work in collaboration with the Chaplain to facilitate Bible Study Connect Groups across campus and online.
- Work in collaboration with the Young Adult Leaders of Uni Church to provide a connected opportunity on Saturday mornings.
- Host one Pulse per semester

Each SALT leader will also be required to:

- Provide summary reports and evaluations to the Chaplain
- Take an occasional staff worship
- Attend our weekly SALT leadership gathering
- Be pursuing an intentional relationship with God
- Be available during non-semester times for planning meetings via Zoom
- Work in collaboration with the Chaplain to build a team around them to support their area of leadership in order for that area to be the most effective that it can be. The weight of each space will not solely rely on the one leader but on the team that will execute the vision.
- Program and share with Chaplain roster that includes event/activity in and around campus and who is involved and leading in that area
