POSITION PURPOSE

The ANSA Health and Well-being Residence Assistant (RA) lives in the Nurses' Residence. The RA will be responsible for co-ordinating, facilitating, supporting and promoting student-based well-being/spiritual activities for Avondale residential students.

KEY RESPONSIBILITIES

- Working with and informing and advising the ANSA President, Sydney campus Chaplain/Student Life Services of all student associated ministry plans.
- Creating community amongst the students within the Nurses Residence.
- Liaising and working with the Nurses' Residence Housing Manager.
- Working with the ANSA Secretary, Media Officer, Social and Spiritual Leaders to allocate the appropriate budgets for operating the student associated ministries.
- Facilitate multi-faith programs and foster respect for other faith traditions.
- Maintaining a close working relationship with the Sydney Campus Chaplain, seeking advice and assistance to ensure a well-balanced and well-suited program of events is achieved each semester.
