POSITION: **AVONDALE UNIVERSITY COUNCIL UNDERGRADUATE STUDENT MEMBER**

Reports to: Avondale University Chancellor

Position Purpose

The Avondale University Council Undergraduate Student Member shall, as a Director of the company:

- support Avondale in its purpose and operation, and
- represent the undergraduate student voice at the highest governing body of the institution.

Key Responsibilities

- Uphold Avondale's purpose, values and ethos
- Work with Council to protect and improve the student experience at Avondale
- Act in good faith, honestly and for a proper purpose
- Be responsible and accountable to the Council
- Ensure that the processes and duties of the Council are carried out in accordance with the Constitution.

Person Specification

- Can demonstrate a connection with the purpose, values and ethos of the University and have a specific connection with the special character of the University.
- Can hold Council matters in strict confidentiality
- Possesses a strong interest in, and contribution towards, student welfare
- Can make decisions in the best interests of Avondale University
- Can declare themselves a fit and proper person with relevant government departments
- Be available to attend Council meetings (5 meetings scheduled per year).

Eligibility

According to the Constitution, the undergraduate student representative must:

- be an undergraduate student of Avondale,
- not be a member of the Avondale staff,
- be either in their final or second-last year of their undergraduate course of study at Avondale, and
- be elected by the undergraduate students of Avondale in the manner prescribed in the Constitution.

Term of Appointment

This person will hold office for the duration of their enrolment as an undergraduate student of Avondale or until the end of the calendar year following the commencement of their office as a Councillor, whichever is the shorter period. It is noted there is no remuneration for this position.
